The EU Erasmus + project SmartHome4Seniors is addressed to older adults of 55+ years who have basic ICT skills and are interested in becoming in charge of Smart Home devices by learning how they actually work.

Older adults can benefit from smart home devices in their everyday lives for a long and independent life in the comfort of their home.

AIM

The aim of the project is to guide older adults into the world of DIY smart home automation solutions to ease their everyday lives and increase their safety. At the same time, participation in this project will address their privacy concerns when using smart home devices, as seniors will learn new skills or enhance existing ones in the fields of electronics, programming, problem-solving and critical thinking.

- to security (cameras, locks),
- entertainment (television, voice assistants),
- energy efficiency (through optimal electricity consumption),
- comfort (windows and blinds managed automatically)
- health support (devices that monitor the health conditions of the user, allowing information to be shared with doctors and/or family members)




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LTTA IN ATHENS

The partners met in Athens in June to take a more detailed look at the kit and to get to work with it. They tested the different functions and discussed how to use them in their national pilotings. The exchange was important to become familiar with the skills and requirements beforehand.



THE KITS ARE ON THE WAY

The kits have already been shipped and are on their way to the different countries. The first step is to test the kit, refresh the knowledge and develop a module for it. Afterwards, the next phase will follow.



NEXT STEPS

The partners are in the process of developing their modules and translating the manual. This is very important for the piloting phase. The next meeting will take place in December, when the next steps will be discussed face to face.
